SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

If you are seeking assistance in applying for SNAP benefits, we are here to help. This program, if you are qualified, would allow you and your family to purchase food from grocery stores with the use of an EBT card. We will assist you through the application process by providing assistance completing the application, making all necessary copies, and turning in your application to the local Welfare office. We are providing these services via the telephone. To apply, call Elizabeth Guillen or Joslyn Mendez SNAP Advocates at 702-343-3274 or 702-305-0572. All services are free.

Have these items, if applicable, available when you call:

- Picture Id
- Alien Registration Card
- Social Security Card for all family members
- Last 3 current pay check stubs
- If employment ended in the last 90 days verification of the job ending
- Social Security Award Letter
- Pension Letter
- Child Support (print out if currently paying or receiving)
- Current Bank Statement
- Letter from any source of income of friends or family assisting you by paying bills or giving money
- Residency Verification (lease, mortgage statement, rent receipt, letter from landlord and utility bill)
